


Pendragon Pre-school News Letter

New Topic

We will be looking at people who help us this term and we will hopefully get lots of visitors in to tell the children about their jobs and how they help us. Wow Words

The current WOW words are 'Life Cycle' and 'Roots'.

These were chosen because we are talking about different bugs life cycles and what a plant needs to grow and how it helps them to grow. Our wow words will continue until the children have retained the meaning of the word.

Letter and Sounds

In letters and sounds Mrs Allan has been playing digging for treasure. The children dig for an object and then have to place in on the correct letter the object starts with.



<u>Opal</u>

The children are allowed to play with the Opal equipment on the school field we do this on different days throughout the week. We understand the weather is getting nicer and your child may want to wear sandals however can we please ask you to pop a pair of closed toe shoes in their bags just in case.
