Easter Bonnets

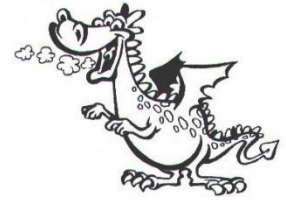
All Easter bonnets to be in by Monday please, giving the Easter Bunny time to come and judge them. Easter bonnets are to be made at home as it is a competition.
