

Frequently Asked Questions

How will my child start school?

Children starting Foundation Stage in September will attend on a part time basis either in the morning or the afternoon. This is organised according to your child's birthday in order to ensure an even split across the cohort.

What will my child need to bring to school?


Your child will need to bring a book bag to school (this will be purchased for them as a welcome gift by the school), a water bottle and a piece of fruit for morning snack and a packed lunch if you choose not to take advantage of the free snack and lunch provided by the government.

What are the arrangements for lunchtime?

Once in full time your child will receive a hot lunch every day free of charge as part of the government scheme. They are also entitled to free snack everyday which will include a piece of fruit or vegetable.

What will my child do at school?

Predominantly your child will learn through play during their first year of school with the expectation that they participate in whole class teaching sessions followed by small group or one to one work with the teacher and/or teaching assistants.




