National Curriculum


As **Readers** we will read and explore a range of non-fiction texts linked to our science topic. We will also be continuing to read a variety of text extracts in our guided reading sessions and enjoying listening to our daily class reader.

As **Writers** we will be looking at an age-appropriate adaptation of Shakespeare's Macbeth with a drama focus. Following that, we will be learning about the features of a biography and writing our own linked to our Science topic.



What makes our planet so amazing?

Year 5 - Summer 1



As **Artists** we will be focussing on sculpture. We will create our own 3D card sculptures inspired by Kandinsky's paintings.

In **DT** we will be learning about Food: 'Celebrating culture and seasonality'. This will be linked to preparing food for our French Café later this half term.

In **PE** we will be developing our striking and fielding skills in cricket. We will also be improving our skills in athletic events.

What is our solar system like?

As **Scientists** we will be learning about the movement of the Earth, and other planets in our solar system, in relation to the Sun. We will also describe the movement of the Moon around the Earth. We will use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night, and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky. We will learn about scientists who had significant impact on our understanding of the solar system such as Galileo and Copernicus.

As **Mathematicians** we will look at converting units of measure, volume and capacity. We will introduce percentages and use them to solve problems. We will also be calculating the perimeter of rectilinear shapes.

As **Linguists**, we will build on last term's learning about food, to learn how to order foods as part of our French Café.

In **PSHCE** we will develop our understanding of healthy and safer lifestyles focusing on personal safety. We will also have a visit from the Life Bus.

As **Musicians** we will be using the song 'Dancing in the Street' to develop our skills of singing, composing, playing instruments and performing.

In **RE** we will consider what we can learn from reflecting on Christian, Sikh and Muslim wisdom.

In **Computing** we will be developing our word processing skills.









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Supporting Learning at Home

- Mathletics: www.mathletics.co.uk will be set on Fridays and due the following Thursday.
- Maths: Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) will be sent home to learn each half term. This half term's KIRF is: to be able to recall metric conversions.
- © **Times Tables** Please continue to practise multiplication tables up to 12 × 12 as this was a target for the end of Year 4.
- © **Spelling** Children will be provided with a spelling activity to complete at home. This will be sent home on Fridays and should be returned on the following Thursday.
- © Reading book Ideally read daily for at least 10-15mins. Children earn a sticker for their Bookflix loyalty card every time they complete a book review or character profile for each book they read. Once they complete a card, they get to spin the prize wheel at school. Children are being encouraged to read titles from the Year 5 Recommended Reads booklist.
