### Oral Health Takeaway

We are delighted that Devonshire House Dental Practice in Cambridge are continuing to support our tooth-friendly snack policy of fresh fruit and vegetables (not dried) as well as helping us to promote good Oral Health habits to the whole school. They are kindly continuing to fund the 1<sup>st</sup> day back carrots for KS1 morning breaktime snack as well as the Oral Health Takeaways which your child will bring home this evening. Awesome Oral Health CIC. the social enterprise which runs the Raisin Awareness dental link up, has further resources on the website www.awesomeoral-health.com which can be downloaded for free. This will soon also include a guide on "How to find an NHS" dentist" which has become increasingly difficult in recent years. NHS dental care for children under 18 is free but spaces are limited. It is important that every child visits a dentist for a check up at least once a year even if they are having no problems. Please note that if you do manage to get your child registered with an NHS dentist that you must keep going regularly for appointments to stay registered. If you require further assistance please contact the school office.



Pendragon lunches are healthy and delicious. All children in Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to have a school dinner for free. School dinners are available at a cost of £2.30 per day for all other year groups. These can be paid for at the beginning of the week, on the day or half termly in advance using our online payment Parent Pay system. Access arrangements for MCAS (My child at school) will be given to you once your child has started school.

Year 3 -6 are encouraged to bring a piece of fruit for their mid morning snack. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have a piece of fruit provided for them.
