Dear Parents and Carers

Today is the start of the summer term and as promised before the Easter break, a new set of learning plans will be coming out today. In addition, staff have completed welfare visits to you all and so you should all have a bag containing this term's KIRFs (key instant recall facts), and some exercise books for your children to work in, on your door step today in Papworth and over the next couple of days if you are out of the village.

We fully appreciate that some of the children have now been at home with you for 4 weeks. Hopefully this has given you all an opportunity to settle into some kind of routine.

From this week, you will be receiving a list of suggested learning arriving every Friday afternoon ready for the start of the following week. This is not a list that has to be completed but a suggestion of up to 3 hours of learning a day that can take place at a time that suits you and your family during the week. All learning plans will be on the website for you to reference. Why not pick and mix, depending on what else is happening in your house each day. Every house is different, please do whatever you can. If you want an idea of how to plan your day why not have a look at the timetable attached.

Our minimum expectation is that the children read daily, either with you or independently, practise this new term's KIRFS, practise their weekly spellings or phonics and do some form of writing. We will not be expecting you to teach the children but work alongside them as they continue to learn and practise concepts they have already met in school.

We appreciate that working 1:1 with your child can be very intense and so we advise that you pick and mix from the activity list to suit your own household. Certainly in school we will be taking lots of breaks outside, having some quiet time every day and mixing up activities which are adult led and also those which let the children have a go by themselves. The BBC has today started a schedule of lessons and appropriate television programmes that can be accessed via the red button or BBC i Player.

Teachers will be in contact with all of you at least once a week by email to check how everything is going with the activities. Year 1 to Year 6 have access directly to their teachers using Purple Mash. If you have any school issues or difficulties accessing the activities or engaging your child, please contact your child's class teacher directly or via the school office and we will get back to you.

Please can I remind all Keyworkers that if you are not required in work and you are not sleeping following a night shift, your children should be at home with you. If you have not yet informed us of your latest shift pattern please can you e mail the school office asap so we know who to expect in school. Our School Cook is back in tomorrow and so can provide a school dinner if required.
