It is great to see so many of you walking to school with the children. Please can I ask once you have dropped off that you keep the pavements clear so that children are able to walk into school without needing to go into the road. Some children do not like dogs and find it very difficult to walk past them (even friendly ones), so if you could wait away from the gate it would be helpful. I have been informed of an incident this week where a car has driven onto the pavement and nearly hit a child. Please can you be patient when waiting to pass parked vehicles especially at busy times. The Varrier Jones Foundation are very happy to allow any parent to park behind the shops and studio and walk up to school on a morning- a really good way to start the day with some fresh air.

<u>Attendance</u>

Getting your child to school on time really does matter! The gates open for Years 1-6 at 8.40 am and 8.45 am for Foundation stage; registration is at 8.55am. If in a school year, your child is late in everyday by 5 minutes that equates to approximately 3.5 days absent from school over the whole year. 95% attendance at the end of the year means your child has missed 10 days from school, 90% attendance at the end of the year is 19 missed days- just short of 4 working weeks! We all know that children can be very susceptible to bugs at this time of year and appreciate your support in the 48 hour rule on sickness and diarrhoea but a cough may not need a day off school.
