"In our outside area we can learn, we were reading books about beans with Mrs Willmore. It's nice outside you can hear the birds singing."



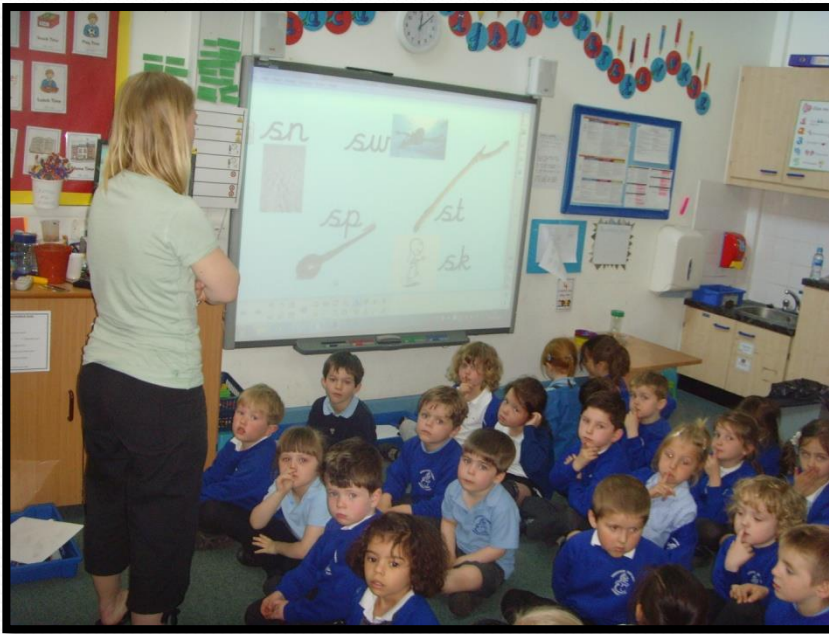
"I couldn't write my name neatly, now I can. I can write using cursive writing it looks really neat"

"We learn about measuring."

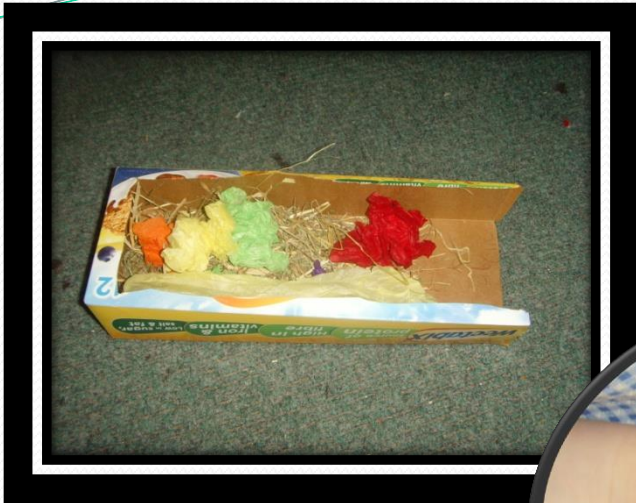
"We can use Numicon."

Displays



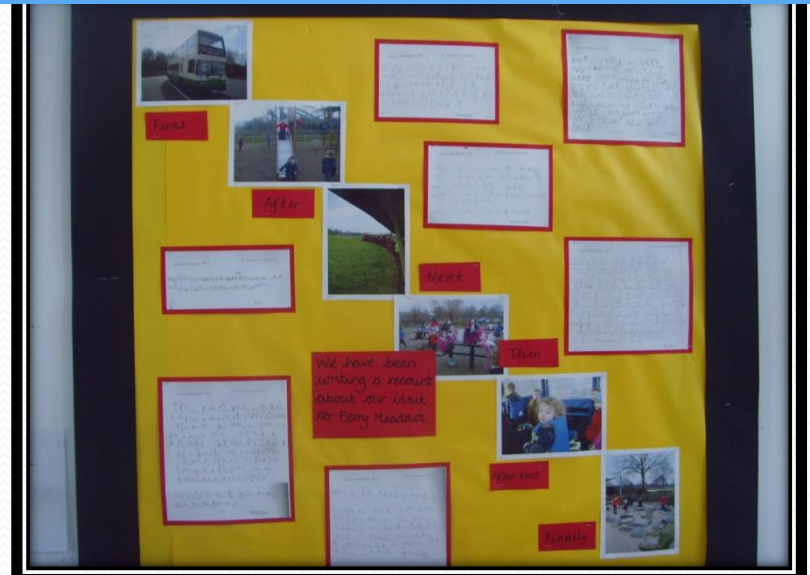
"This is where we can show our mummy or daddy what we have been doing."
