School timings

Morning Routine

- Main gates open 8:35am
- School starts at 8:45am
- Main gates close at 8:55am
- Use the front office if you arrive once the gates are closed
- Y3-6 line up on the playground and wait to be greeted by their teacher

Children in y5 and 6 walking/ cycling independently to and from school must do so sensibly. Parents will be informed if pupils are reported to be unsafe on the roads. We will operate a three strike system before requesting parents to bring the children to school for an agreed amount of time.



Uniform

General uniform

- a blue sweatshirt and a white or sky blue polo shirt (logos not necessary)
- grey trousers or skirt
- black shoes on non P.E. days preferably with a waterproof surface (eg not plimsoles)

P.E. Kit Children need to have:

- a T-shirt (house colour or plain white) and a pair of shorts or jogging bottoms/leggings
- a pair of trainers for P.E. days
- · children should have tracksuits available for the colder weather
- No football kits

Jewellery
Watches (excluding smart or camera watches), sleeper and stud earnings are acceptable but are the responsibility of the children.

All jewellery must be removed for P.E. lessons unless there are medical or religious reasons why this is not possible, in which case it must be covered with tape provided from home.





As we are an OPAL school, we require all children to have wellies/spare shoes, waterproof gear and access to spare clothes as we go out in all weathers.



Year 4

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.
