

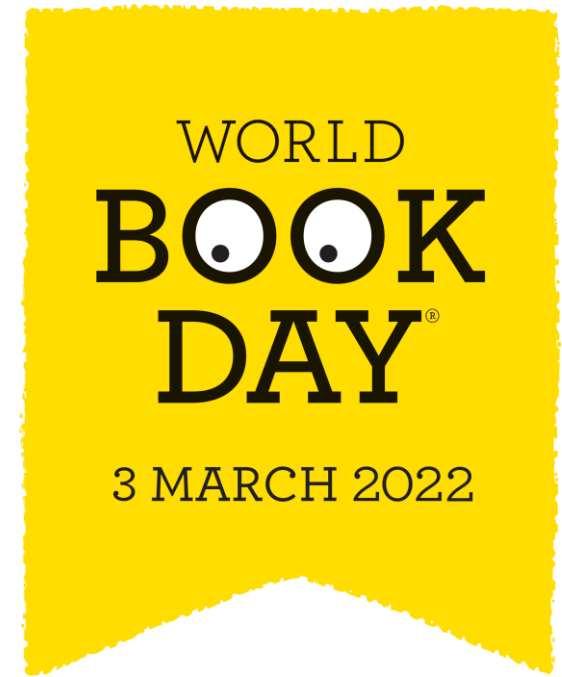
Children's University and World Book Day!
