National Curriculum

As **Readers** we will read and explore non-fiction texts linked to our Science learning. We will read and perform poems to the class. We will also be continuing to read a variety of age-appropriate extracts in our daily guided reading sessions. As a class, we will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom.



As **Writers** we will listen to a variety of public speakers, then write and deliver our own speeches on the theme of the value of education. We will have opportunities to write in a variety of ways in Pendragon Writers Club.

In **DT** we will be learning about using computeraided design in textiles to make our own bags. We will also investigate the use of pulleys.

As **Musicians** we will be using the song "To make you feel my love" by Adele to develop our skills of singing, playing musical instruments listening and composing.

As **Linguists**, we will be continuing to learn vocabulary associated with time. We will then be learning how to express opinions and food linked to opinions. What makes our world wonderful? Year 5 – Spring 1

As **Mathematicians** we will be learning to use formal methods of division. We will also explore fractions (equivalence, comparing and ordering, adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions).

changes of materials. We will compare and group




In **Computing** we will be using Purple Mash to create our own databases.
