National Curriculum



As **Readers** we will studying the text 'Storm Keeper's Island' by Catherine Doyle. We will use this to inspire our writing. We will also be reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to our learning in ther subjects, and analysing poetry and song lyrics. We will answer comprehension questions on these texts.



As **mathematicians** we will be developing our understanding of place value and properties of numbers up to one million. We will learn about negative numbers and decimals up to three decimal places. We will also develop our understanding of rounding numbers and learn to multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

As **artists** we will be looking at how plants are depicted by different artisits. We will use different mediums to create different styles of artwork. We will look at work by Henri Rousseau and David Hockney.

As **Historians** we will be learning all about the Maya civilisation and investigating why their empire came to such an abrupt end.



As **musicians**, we will be learning songs to perform at the upcoming Young Voices event at the O2.

In **PE** we will be learning yoga and also developing our netball skills.

In **Computing** we will be learning about e-safety and also using Purple Mash to develop our coding skills.

In **PSHE** we will be discussing the topic 'Beginning and Belonging'. We will then be learning about anitbullying and what we can do to prevent it. As **Writers** we will be learning a text through our Talk for Writing oral rehearsal. We will be using this alongside Storm Keeper's Island to try new techniques to make our writing engaging. We will also be writing poetry based on the poem Meeting Midnight by Carol Ann Duffy.

In French we will be looking at the topic 'Describing me and others'. We will be learning vocabulary associated with back to school; dates and birthdays and describing items in the classroom. In all lessons, we will also be learning French phonics to support our pronunciation.

In **RE** we will be learning about Justice and Freedom. We will consider how people should be treated in our world today.

As **Scientists** we will be learning about living things, focusing on animal classification. We will discuss differences between vertebrates and invertebrates. As well as this we will learn about the three kingdoms – animals, plants, fungi, protists and monera.

☺ Maths

Work will be provided to practise what has been learned in class as an activity in the homework book and on **Mathletics**:<u>www.mathletics.co.uk</u>

Spelling.

Children will be provided with a perosnalised spelling list. Each week they should practise and learn 10 of the words from their spelling lists.

③ Reading book

Ideally read **daily** for at least 15-20mins.. Children earn a sticker for their Bookflix loyalty card every time they complete a book review or character profile for each book they read. Once they complete a card, they get to spin the prize wheel at school. Children are being encouraged to read titles from the Year 5 Recommended Reads booklist.

☺ KIRFs:

This half term's KIRFs are to learn **decimal number bonds to 1 and 10** e.g.

0.6 + 0.4 = 1	3.7 + 6.3 = 10
1 - 0.4 = 0.6	10 - 6.3 = 3.7
0.75 + 0.25 = 1	4.8 + 5.2 = 10
1 – 0.25 = 0.75	10 - 4.8 = 5.2
