Trinity Mirror Real Schools guide

I understand that this newspaper guide to schools has been causing some concerns amongst some parents. Assessment data for Foundation, Year 2 and Year 6 from 2018 is on the school website. I am trying to find out how the guide makes it calculations especially to form some of its conclusions. The majority of the guide concentrates on the test results of the 33 children who finished year 6 with us. Teacher assessment and other areas of the children's progress was not taken into account. Pupil progress is always a major discussion point with all staff and Governors. An in depth analysis of the children's results and their progress from Keystage 1 has been completed looking at all areas of the children's learning and teaching. This has been shared with governors and with the LA. I cannot comment directly on individual children's progress but would be happy to meet with anyone to discuss how we monitor progress across the school.
